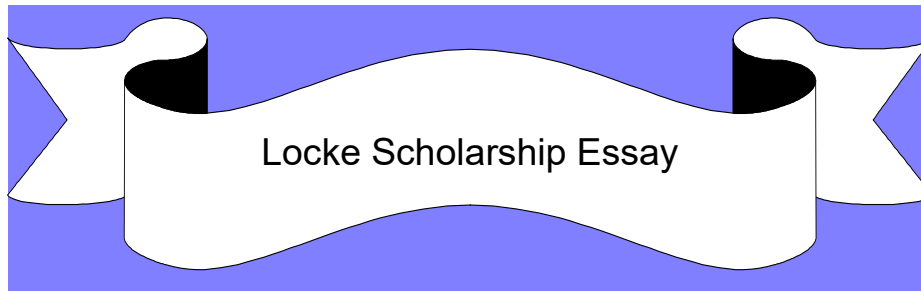




The Locke Scholarship honors Brother Dr. Alain L. Locke, the first Black Rhodes Scholar and a distinguished member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. He was called 'The Education Man' by many of his contemporaries. This scholarship honors Dr. Locke's dedication to education.

The following criteria has been established for all Locke Scholarship applicants:

- Must be a graduating high school senior in Metro-Atlanta to apply
- Applicant must have obtained high school diploma by the start of the Fall college/university semester/quarter
- Two page typed written double spaced essay (12 point Times New Roman Font)
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Must have a letter of acceptance **or** pending letter of acceptance to an accredited college/university
Note: Winners must enroll and attend an accredited college/university to receive funds. This is a one-time scholarship.
- Funds will be distributed by end of October only after enrollment verification
- Must have two recommendations on official high school letterhead
 1. Counselor or principal
 2. Instructor
- No special field of study required
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident or possess a student visa
- Winners will be notified by The Locke Scholarship Committee - Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.



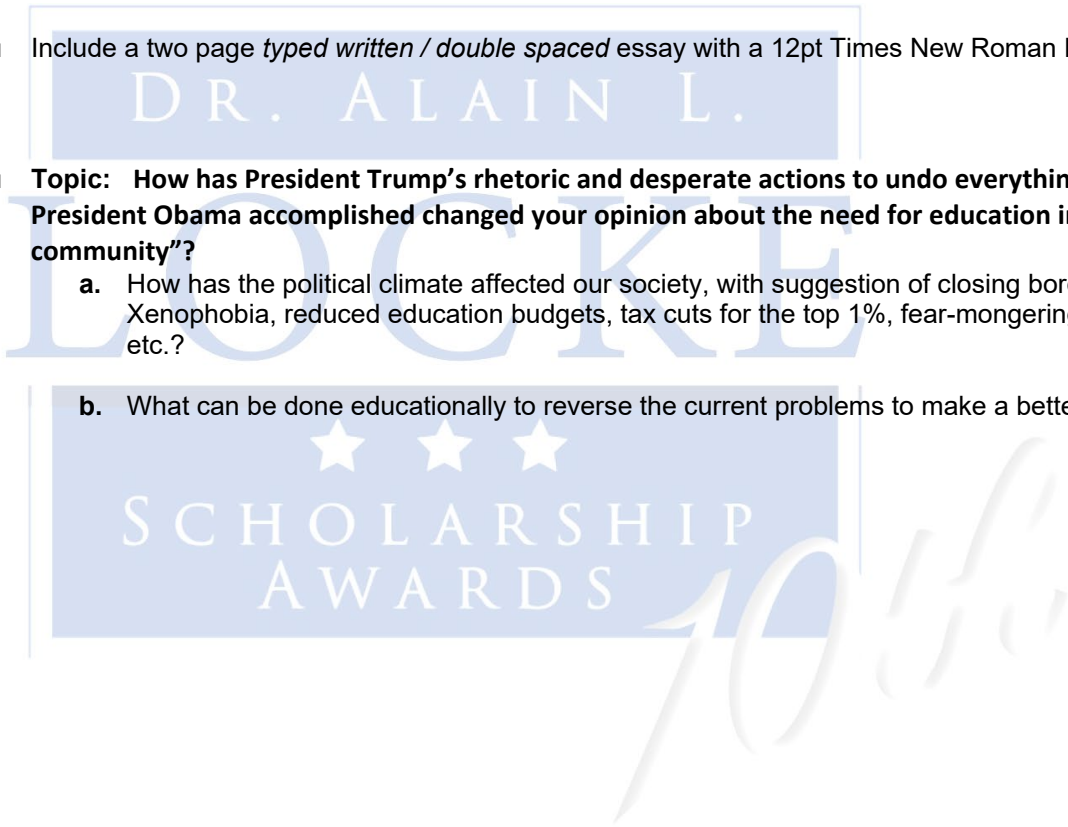

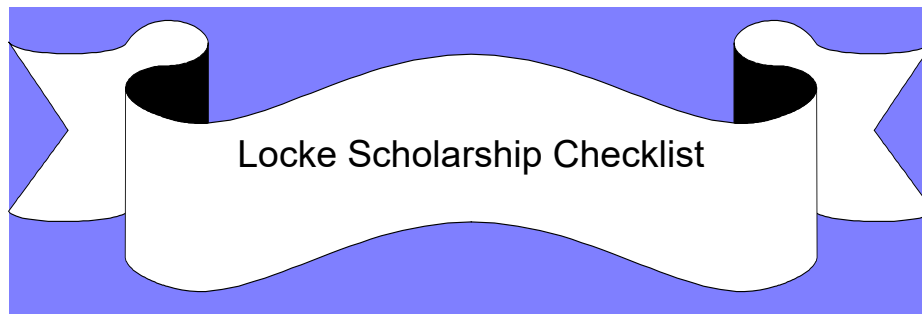
- Include a two page *typed written / double spaced* essay with a 12pt Times New Roman Font.

- Include a small senior color photo
- Student signature required on the application
- Parents/guardians signatures required on the application
- Include two typed written recommendations on official high school letterhead
1. Counselor or principal 2. Instructor
- Certified copy of high school transcript in envelope sealed by counselor/principal
- A copy of college/university acceptance letter **or** a letter/note from the Office of Admission confirming application receipt
- Application deadline: Postmarked by January 31, 2019
- Retain a copy of each document mailed in the completed package for your reference/file
